The Refuge consists of approximately 16,000 acres and is divided into several management units: Leadbetter Point Unit at the northern tip of Long Beach Peninsula; Long Island in the southern part of the bay; and Porter's Point, Bear River, Teal Slough, Tarlatt, Lewis, and Riekkola Units at the south end of the bay.
