Volunteer Job Description for Maintenance Assistant

Position Purpose

Assist refuge maintenance crews to maintain lands, trails, facilities, and equipment in safe and fully functional condition to support public use and refuge operations.

Duties

- Maintain grounds thorough mowing, weed whacking, and litter cleanup including emptying trash cans
- Maintain facilities, roads, and infrastructure through general upkeep and repairs
- Repair and maintain boats, vehicles, and equipment
- Operation of hand and power tools
- Trail and grounds upkeep, such as tree trimming, trail maintenance, mowing grass, clearing brush, and weed control through mechanical and chemical applications
- Work must be conducted in a safe manner at all times

Qualifications

- Basic understanding, interest, and appreciation for the preservation of natural resources
- Use of common hand tools
- Use of basic powered equipment like mowers and string trimmers
- Knowledge of basic construction/maintenance techniques
- Good communication skills and a positive attitude

Training: Training for this position will be provided by a refuge staff member.

Work Environment: Can be physically demanding – Heavy lifting, work stooping, bending, kneeling, standing, and ladder use is required; often working outdoors in remote areas with potential for extreme heat, cold and insects.

Time Commitment: Minimum of four hours per week.

Age Requirement: You must be 18 years old or older to be a Maintenance Assistant. You must be at least 18 years old and successfully complete a Defensive Driving Training to drive a refuge vehicle.
