### Step by Step Guidelines & Conservation Measures

#### Step 4. Determining whether your activity is likely to disturb nesting bald eagles.

##### **You have determined that your activity is one of the following:**

Building construction, 1 or 2 story, with a project footprint of 1/2 acre or less

Construction of roads, trails, canals, power lines, and other linear utilities.

Agriculture or aquaculture operations - new or expanded.

Alteration of shoreline or wetlands.

Installation of docks or moorings.

Water impoundment.

**You have determined that the bald eagle nest (active or alternate) can be seen from the project site and that there is no similar activity within 660 feet of the nest.**

**Therefore, to avoid disturbing nesting eagles and their young, we recommend that you:**

- 1. maintain a buffer of at least 660 feet (200 meters) between your activities and the nest (including *active and alternate nests*),**
- 2. maintain any established landscape buffers, and**
- 3. if possible, create additional landscape buffers to screen the new activity from the nest.**
