Next Steps:

- 1) Take a good look at State survey and address those concerns and comments (**Scoping Team**).
- 2) Expand the partner dialogue with tribes, NGOs, JVs, FHPs, and Heritage programs.
- 3) Address all levels of the partner organizations.
- 4) Develop a single unified message.
- 5) Identify the “who” first to identify the “what” (**Scoping Team**).
- 6) Integrated scoping activity starts with known partners.
- 7) Look at existing plans (i.e. SWAPs). Consult access database of “plans” – see Cindy Bohn.
- 8) Look at notes from the Region 4 Biologist Conference to investigate issues of scope, etc. Check with Chuck Hunter for information in help setting priorities.
- 9) Possible development of an MOU.
- 10) Set up scoping team to generate messages.
- 11) Plan a summit – include as many folks as possible – Bill Reeves comments.
- 12) Folks to work on standing up LCC (formation):
 - Region 3 – Bill McCoy, Mary Knapp, Scott Pruitt, Maureen Gallagher (point).
 - Region 4 – Brian Cole, Bill Wayman, Dwight Cooley
 - Region 5 – Cindy Schulz, Deb Carter, Roberta Hylton, Callie McMunigal
- 13) Be careful not to tap folks out. Think regionally about all LCC needs.
- 14) Concept Plan first, then refine and expand to an operational plan. Due date in two plus years.
