The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service:

- Employs 86 people in the state of Arkansas.
- Manages more than 357,795 acres of federal land.
- Contributes \$6.7 million in payroll and operations budgets annually.
- Hosts more than 1.1 million visitors at national wildlife refuges and fish hatcheries.
- Stocks more than 4.9 million fish annually to support mitigation of federal water development projects and anadromous fish restoration and recovery efforts.
- Federal Aid to State Fish and Wildlife Programs channeled:
 - \$5.4 million for sport fish restoration.
 - \$3.3 million for wildlife restoration and hunter education.
