The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service:

- Employs 341 people in the state of Georgia.*
- Manages more than 461,281 acres of federal land.
- Contributes \$26.4 million* in payroll and operations budgets annually.
- Hosts over one million visitors at national wildlife refuges and fish hatcheries.
- Stocks more than 1.5 million fish annually to support anadromous fish restoration in the coastal rivers of the Gulf of Mexico and mitigation of federal water development projects.
- Federal Aid to State Fish and Wildlife Programs channeled:

\$5.4 million for sport fish restoration.

\$4 million for wildlife restoration and hunter education.
