The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service:

- Employs 57 people in the state of South Carolina.
- Manages over 186,089 acres of federal land.
- Contributes \$4.7 million in payroll and operations budgets annually.
- Hosts over 455,000 visitors at national wildlife refuges and fish hatcheries.
- Stocks more than 5 million fish annually to support anadromous fish restoration in the coastal rivers of the South Atlantic and addressed imperiled fish species declines.
- Federal Aid to State Fish and Wildlife Programs channeled:

\$3.5 million for sport fish restoration.

\$2.7 million for wildlife restoration and hunter education.
