Description: The training will provide you with 8 of the 40 hours necessary to conduct Mexican spotted owl surveys on your own or serve as a refresher, if needed. The training will go through the 2012 FWS Survey Protocol and we will visit Mexican spotted owl suitable habitat as part of the training. Please plan on bringing lunch (and dinner, just in case) as we are going to fit a lot into a day and it will make it easier if people do not have to go find food. Also, since we will be going in the field, please bring appropriate clothing and shoes for walking in the woods. Please bring any field gear you might need. If you currently have an FWS permit, please bring your permit as well.
