Field Session. June 14. 6:30 am-10:30 am, Bosque del Apache NWR parking lot (please park in areas highlighted in red on the map). Bring binoculars, hiking boots, tight fitting hat, water, pencils, data sheet, bug spray, snacks and sunscreen. Be prepared for hot weather.
