

**Title:** 2018 Southwestern Willow Flycatcher Survey Training in AZ

**When:** May 17 and 18, 2018

**Where:** Roosevelt Lake, AZ

The 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Arizona Southwestern Willow Flycatcher Survey Training workshop will be held Thursday and Friday, May 17 and 18<sup>th</sup>, 2018. The first day of training will be an afternoon classroom session held at the USFS Roosevelt Lake Visitor Center. The second day will be a morning field trip (gathering at a yet to be determined site at Roosevelt Lake) to visit flycatcher sites on the east side of Roosevelt Lake and the Salt River.

Details are still being developed. Camping will be available for attendees at a Roosevelt Lake Grapevine Camping group site. Lodging is available in the Roosevelt Lake/Tonto Basin area or a little farther away (but still reasonable driving distance) in the Globe/Miami area.
