

## Guidelines for how long an animal survey in Oklahoma is valid

If a survey, however old, has a positive species occurrence, further coordination with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service will be required. This list provides a general guideline for how long a negative survey (a survey in which no listed species were found) remains valid. These timeframes provide general recommendations; site specific circumstances may require that these general guidelines be modified.
