


Williams Creek NFH Visitors Map

Williams Creek NFH Nature Trail

The nature trail starts at the picnic area near the parking lot and continues for approximately 1,000 feet, and treks through a grove of trees to a deck overlooking two ponds.

You will have a better chance of seeing wildlife if you approach the deck slowly and quietly. Wildlife, especially waterfowl, will flee the area quickly if they see or hear you coming. The ponds and the area surrounding them provides wonderful habitat for many different species of animals. Signs mounted on the deck describe species commonly found in this habitat.

For your own safety PLEASE STAY ON THE DECK. The water in the ponds is deep, and the tall grass harbors snakes. Enjoy yourself as you explore the many sights and sounds that the trail and surrounding habitat can provide.
