



Pahranagat Roundtail Chub Species Information

Scientific Name: *Gila robusta jordani*

Family: Cyprinidae

Description: Freshwater fish growing up to 10 inches. Have scales above and below the lateral line. It is a greenish color with dark blotches. Pahranagat roundtail chub are elongated fish with a narrow caudal peduncle.

Status: Endangered, October 13, 1970

Native Area: Historically found in the spring waters in the Pahranagat Valley, Lincoln County, Nevada. They are now confined to the Ash Springs and the Pahranagat River downstream through the Burns Ranch.

Additional Comments: The Dexter National Fish Hatchery & Technology Center in Dexter, New Mexico, maintains a refugia population.
