



Willow Beach National Fish Hatchery June 2014 Monthly Report



No fish were stocked this month.

131 visitors signed the guest registry.

The trout received from Arizona Game and Fish are growing as projected. There are 5,473 fish at 10.22 inches and 14,983 fish at 6.64 inches. These fish will be grown out until October and stocked below Davis Dam.

Bernie Freeman and Robert Baca, Region 2 Engineers hosted a meeting at the hatchery for other engineers from Mohave County, Arizona Game & Fish and private contractor to brainstorm cost effective solutions to repair/replace the river water intake pipeline. In addition, Mohave County surveyors and Friday construction returned to get accurate

elevations on the pipeline in the river and where the pipeline enters the pump sump.

Maintenance activities included: Trenching and installing 160 feet of 6 inch pipe for the new well development project; an electrical contractor repaired street lights and moved a breaker panel; leaks were repaired in the air blower line and added a support to the line; repaired floating dock support cable.

Work activities included terrestrial and aquatic weed management; fish feeding and water quality monitoring.

Maintenance activities included painting the interior of the biologist's trailer; replacing tires on a work truck; finishing repairs from the annual safety inspection; annual generator maintenance; installing a water softener; sealing the new deck on the crew trailer and installing a new VFD motor for the pond water supply.
