



\$10,000 REWARD FOR INFORMATION ON MEXICAN WOLVES

A reward of up to \$10,000 is being offered for information leading to the apprehension of individuals responsible for the deaths of, or injury to, Mexican wolves in east-central Arizona.

Intentional acts that cause death or injury to Mexican wolves are violations of the Endangered Species Act, *Title 16, United States Code 1538, Title 50, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 17* and can invoke criminal penalties up to \$50,000 and/or up to one year in jail; and/or a civil penalty of up to \$25,000.
