Please be advised that the above-referenced [Texas Chenier Plain NWR Complex Draft EIS/CCP/LPP](#) which follows on this web-site is now available for your review and comment. The Refuge Complex consists of the Anahuac, Moody, McFaddin and Texas Point National Wildlife Refuges, located along the upper Texas Coast. This document addresses two proposed actions by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service: 1) development of a 15-year management plan (the CCP) for the four wildlife refuges, and 2) expansion of the approved land acquisition boundaries for the four refuges (the LPP).
