

Tualatin River NWR
Refuge-Specific Youth Waterfowl Hunting Regulations

- Age: Youth 17 years of age and younger may participate as active hunters. Youth must be accompanied by an adult 21 years of age or older. Supervising adults are not allowed to hunt.
- A maximum of two hunting youth will be allowed per hunting blind. At least one non-hunting supervising adult must accompany youth hunters. Additional non-hunters may also occupy the blind with a hunting youth and non-hunting adult supervisor for a maximum occupancy of 4 persons per blind.
- Disabled youth hunters must possess an Oregon Disabilities Hunting and Fishing Permit issued by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to qualify for preference in using the ADAAG blind (See <http://www.dfw.state.or.us/resources/hunting/disability> for further information).
- Blinds will be assigned by a random drawing of applications.
- Hunting season will begin on the last weekend of October, as conditions permit, and run through the end of the regular state hunting season. The refuge will not be open for the 3rd period northwest permit zone goose hunt.
- Hunting hours: Official start times are listed in the shooting hours table in the Oregon Game Bird Regulations. Ending shooting time is 1:00 PM for the entire season.
- The hunt area will be open for access 1 ½ hours before legal shooting hours.
- Decoys, other personal property, and trash must be removed.
- Dogs are allowed for retrieving waterfowl.
- Possession of shot size larger than BB will be prohibited.
- All hunters must hunt from designated blinds except to retrieve downed birds.
- Vehicles are restricted to designated parking areas. No overnight camping or parking.
- All hunters must have visible means of retrieving waterfowl such as a float tube, waders or a dog capable of retrieving. No motorized boats are allowed.
- Hunters must check in and check out at a designated check station. Harvest of ducks must be reported prior to leaving the refuge. Harvest of geese must be checked at an ODFW operated goose check station.
- Possession of alcohol by any person in the hunt area is prohibited.
