

## Project Overview

The Western Federal Lands Highway Division of the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), in partnership with the Kenai National Wildlife Refuge (KNWR) and the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF), is planning to design and construct a 1.7-mile, separated recreational trail between the Sterling Highway and the Ski Hill Road with a branch trail leading to the KNWR Visitor Center in Soldotna, Alaska.

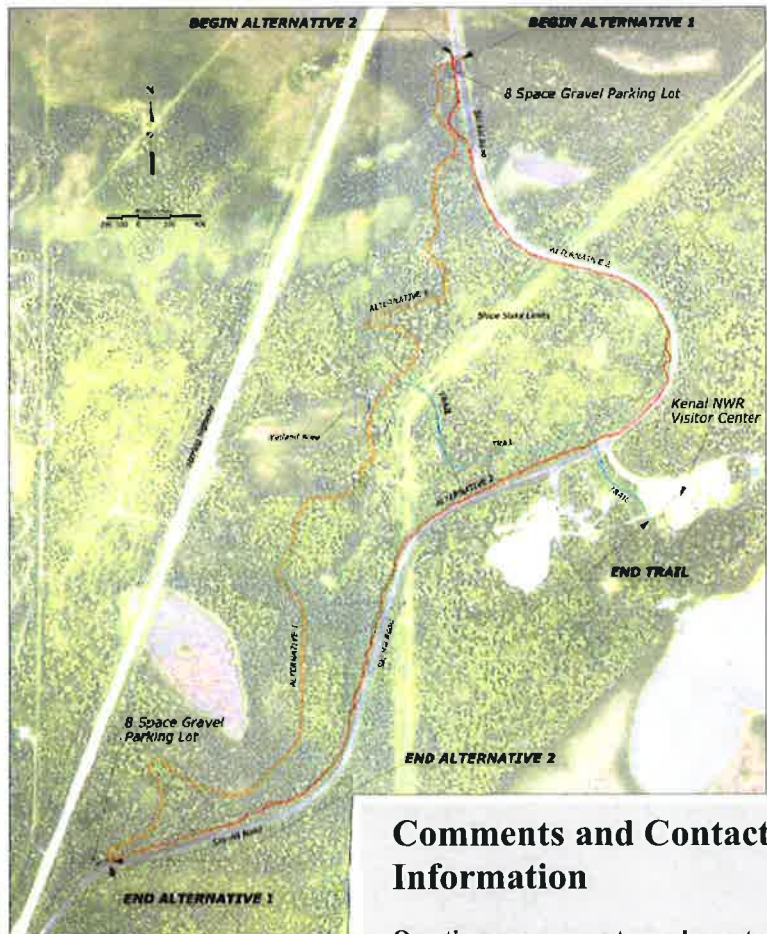
### Project Goals

- » Provide a safer option for walking and bicycling along Ski Hill Road and the Sterling Highway
- » Provide a trail connection to the Refuge Visitor Center and its system of hiking and skiing trails
- » Provide trailhead parking areas
- » Longer term goal:
  - Improve connectivity between community trails, refuge trails, and the Tsalteshi Trails Association trail system
