Continue to enjoy the fall migration this Thanksgiving holiday and weekend at DeSoto National Wildlife Refuge. Please note that the visitor center closes on most federal holidays throughout the year; the center will be closed for the federal holiday, Thursday, November 27. However, the fall migration seasonal sections of the refuge tour road and refuge grounds will remain open that day.

The visitor center will re-open on Friday, November 28 at 8:30 a.m. and remain open 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. daily until the next holiday closure of the center on December 25.

DeSoto National Wildlife Refuge is located 25 miles north of Omaha, Nebraska on U.S. Highway 30, between Missouri Valley, Iowa and Blair, Nebraska. The visitor center is open from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. daily, except federal holidays.
