SUBJECT: Openings Available for Kids to Attend Kenai Refuge Summer Camps

The Kenai National Wildlife Refuge still has space available in Get Out and Get Dirty Summer Camps. There are two session dates July 9-13 or July 16-20. These day camps are for children going into fourth or fifth grade this upcoming school year. These camps give children the opportunity to be 99% outdoors while learning about birds, insects, plants, digital photography and much more.

Campers participate in hands-on activities including: plant pressing, bird identification, orienteering, salmon dissection, & trail art. Camp times are 9 AM -3 PM Monday through Friday. Camps will be held at the Refuge Education Center on Ski Hill Road in Soldotna. There is a \$75 supply fee per camper and pre-registration is required.
