SUBJECT: Kenai National Wildlife Refuge Headquarters Potential Road and Trail Closures

On Monday, April 22, 2013, initial site work will begin on the new Kenai Refuge Visitor Center. Access to Kenai NWR ski trails from the west side of the headquarters building will close on Monday. Access to ski trails from the Keen Eye Trail will remain open.

As construction activity progresses in the coming days and weeks, visitors should prepare for vehicle traffic detours near the Refuge Headquarters and Visitor Center building. The current Refuge Headquarters and Visitor Center will remain open during construction of the new Visitor Center.
