SUBJECT: Swan Lake Road Closure on Kenai National Wildlife Refuge – July 31, 2013

The Kenai National Wildlife Refuge will close Swan Lake Road for culvert repair on July 31, 2013, from approximately 7:30 AM to 3 PM. The road will be closed at mile 5 of Swan Lake Road just east of Sucker Creek and east of the West Entrance of the Swan Lake Canoe Route. It is anticipated that the project can be completed in one work day. We are informing the public, so they can plan their summer activities accordingly.
