SUBJECT: Lower Skilak and Bottenintnin Lake Campground Closures have been Rescinded

On May 25, 2014, the Lower Skilak and Bottenintnin Lake campgrounds (including the boat launch) were closed due to fire danger. Starting at noon today, May 29, 2014, the closures for these campgrounds will be lifted and use of these campgrounds and boat launch may resume. Campfire restrictions remain in place on all Kenai National Wildlife Refuge lands but are being evaluated daily.
