SUBJECT: Campfires Allowed on the Kenai National Wildlife Refuge

Due to the recent rainfall fire danger on the Kenai Peninsula has subsided. Effective immediately, the restriction on having campfires outside of metal fire grates within developed campgrounds has been lifted on the Kenai National Wildlife Refuge. Residents and visitors are still urged to continue to use extreme caution with campfires, or anything that could ignite a fire.
