SUBJECT: Swan Lake Road Closure on Kenai National Wildlife Refuge – Sept. 2 and Sept. 9

The Kenai National Wildlife Refuge will close Swan Lake Road east of Fish Lake for culvert repair, beginning Tuesday, September 2, 2014, at 9 AM. The road will be impassible until reopening at approximately 4:00 PM, on Thursday, September 4, 2014. A second closure will occur beginning at 9:00 AM, on Tuesday, September 9, 2014, and the road will be impassable until reopening at approximately 4:00 PM, on Thursday, September 11, 2014.
