SUBJECT: Fuller Lakes Trail Parking Lot Closure

Kenai National Wildlife Refuge will be temporarily closing Fuller Lakes Trail and parking lot starting October 13, 2015 while Homer Electric Association is replacing a power pole near that location. The parking lot and trail will be closed for public safety reasons, until Homer Electric Association completes the work. The closure is not expected to last more than a few days and the Refuge will notify the public when it reopens.
