SUBJECT: Roadwork to Temporarily Close Access to Swanson River Landing and Campground on Wednesday May 25 through Thursday May 26

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Kenai National Wildlife Refuge, advises that access to the Swanson River Landing and Campground will be closed beginning Wednesday morning May 25th and is expected to remain closed until Thursday afternoon May 26th. Refuge staff will be placing a culvert to correct drainage problems at this location in preparation for new gravel that is to be delivered in June. Deputy Refuge Manager Steve Miller says, “There is never a good time to do this work but we hope that this short closure during the middle of the week will impact the fewest Refuge visitors.”
