



Glacial Ridge Hunt Map

2011 Glacial Ridge National Wildlife Refuge Hunting Regulations

General Information

- All terrain vehicles, off road utility vehicles, and all off-highway vehicles must adhere to MN State Department of Transportation rules and regulations. Vehicles, ATVs, ORUVs, and OHVs are restricted to public roads and parking lots.
- Overnight parking and camping is prohibited
- The building of fires is prohibited
- Pets must be leashed except when being actively used for hunting during the appropriate hunting season.
- Collection of antlers, artifacts and fossils is prohibited.
- Disorderly conduct and leaving of any refuse on the land or water is prohibited.
- The use or possession of alcoholic beverages on a National Wildlife Refuge is prohibited.

Hunting Information

- All hunting is in accordance to Minnesota State Rules and Regulations.
- Deer hunting is open to archery, rifle, and muzzleloader hunting in designated portions of the Refuge. (see map on reverse)
- Upland and Migratory Bird Hunting is available for geese, ducks, coot, common snipe, woodcock, mourning dove, rail, prairie chicken, and sharp-tailed grouse in designated areas. (see map on reverse) All other hunting outside of Deer, Small Game, and Migratory bird, is prohibited.
- Non-toxic shot is required for all shotgun hunting.
- Target shooting is prohibited.
- Hunting with the aid of or distribution of any feed, salt or other mineral is prohibited.
- No permanent stands are permitted. The use of nails, wire, screws or bolts into a tree to attach a stand is prohibited. Portable or temporary hunting blinds or stands can only be set up the day of the hunt, and must be removed at the end of each day.

Accommodations to the above rules need to be in writing and directed to the Refuge Manager (218) 687-2229 and must be received two weeks in advance of visit.
