***BIRD WALK 7:30am – 10:00am**

Spring migration is a great time to see birds. Join former Refuge Manager Jim Krakowski on a bird tour of our public trails. Meet at the Duncan Memorial Trailhead.

***BUGGY TOURS, 8:00, 9:00, 9:30, 10:00, & 10:30**

60-minute buggy tours depart the Roger Roth Work Center and travel through cypress swamps and oak hammocks, where you will feel the wilderness all around you. (Approx. 1 hr.)

***SWAMP WALK ORCHID TOURS WITH LARRY RICHARDSON 8:15am, 9:45, & 11:15** Tours take visitors through beautiful swamps (up to three feet deep), so put on your messy gear and come check out the special and rare orchids that call the refuge home! (Approx. 1.5 hr)

***NATIVE PLANT IDENTIFICATION WALKS 8:30am & 10:15am**

Take a walk with an accomplished botanist as they point out individual plant identifications and discuss forest communities and their relationship to wildlife communities. (Approx. 1.5 hr)

Florida Panther Habitat Walk 9:30am-10:30am

Take a walk with Darryl Thomas as he highlights the various habitats, vegetation, and wildlife species one encounters on the refuge.

HAYRIDES 9:30- 12:00

Pile in and take a 60-minute hayride to explore territory not visited by the buggy tours. Keep your eyes open for rare wildlife like Florida panthers. Limited space; no reservations.

OUTDOOR PRESENTATIONS

Free outdoor presentations on Florida panthers will be given throughout the event by a panther biologist. (Approx. 40 min)

GUIDED TRAIL WALKS

Refuge Trail Guides will give your family a personalized tour through iconic Florida panther habitats. Look for tracks and scat of FP183, whose territory overlaps the trails!



DIRECTIONS (From Naples): I-75 East toward Ft. Lauderdale. Take Exit 80 (State Road 29) and turn north (left). The **Roger Roth Work Center** is ½ mile north of I-75 on SR29 after the refuge trailhead.
