Thank you for your interest in the Mason Neck and Occoquan Bay Management Hunts, coordinated by the Potomac River National Wildlife Refuge Complex, Mason Neck State Park in Fairfax County, and Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries. Read the hunt application form closely to ensure you apply to the correct hunt location. Incorrect or incomplete information may result in a voided application. Applicants ejected or prohibited from participating in ANY previous public managed hunt within Northern Virginia may be disqualified from participation and forfeit all associated fees.

2014 Mason Neck Management Hunt: Three (3) hunting days; Nov. 20, 21, & Dec. 12, 2014.

2014 Occoquan Bay Management Hunt: Two (2) hunting days; Dec. 8 & 10, 2014. If staff determines the hunt has yet to reach desired management goals, an additional hunt day for STANDBY hunters only may be added on Friday, January 9, 2015.

2014 Youth Hunt: The Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries will host a Novice Youth Deer Hunt at Occoquan Bay NWR for beginner hunters ages 12-18 on Dec. 6, 2014. The attached application form cannot be used for the Youth Hunt.

Applications: Applications must be postmarked no later than Sept. 20, 2014. Only one (1) hunter name can be associated with each application. Applications from several people may be mailed in the same envelope and covered by same check. Your application receipt date will be determined by postmark – *Potomac River NWR Complex is not responsible for late or misrouted mail.*
