Join us this summer for monthly nature hikes at Boyer Chute National Wildlife Refuge and discover or rediscover your local refuge located just three miles east of Fort Calhoun, Nebraska. Learn about the nature, history, wildlife habitats, and how its connection to the Missouri River makes the refuge a special place.

The length and time spent hiking will be adapted to the abilities of those who attend the hike. Participants should dress appropriately to be outdoors, wear comfortable walking shoes, bring bug spray, and have plenty of water.

Meet at the kiosk in the main parking lot. Boyer Chute National Wildlife Refuge is located along U.S. Highway 75 near Ft. Calhoun, Nebraska. Follow the signs from U.S. Highway 75 in Ft. Calhoun. Reservations encouraged but not required.
