Extra assignments for high school students who are earning credit hours

Month: September

Research the importance of hollow logs and dead standing trees (called “snags”) for wildlife habitat. Make a list of animals that use hollow logs and/or snags and for what purpose. How does each animal use the hollow log or snag? For example, as shelter from predators? A place to rest and sleep? A place to find food? A place to store food? Or a place to raise their family?

Write a one page article based on your research. What did you learn?

Then select one animal to feature in a PowerPoint slide show. Create three to five slides illustrating the importance of the hollow log or tree snag to your selected animal. The design of each slide should include both text and graphics. Graphics includes something visual besides words such as an illustration, drawing, original art, photograph, clipart, diagram or map.
