7:30 am to 12:30 pm

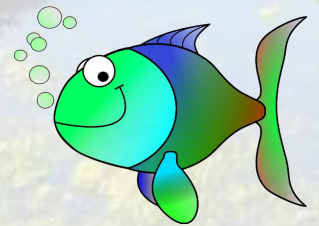
Youth ages 12 and under are invited to learn about:
