# Sport Fishing Regulations

Sand Lake National Wildlife Refuge allows fishing at five locations indicated by the points on the reverse of this brochure. A special permit is not needed. The following rules and regulations apply to all fishing areas on the refuge.

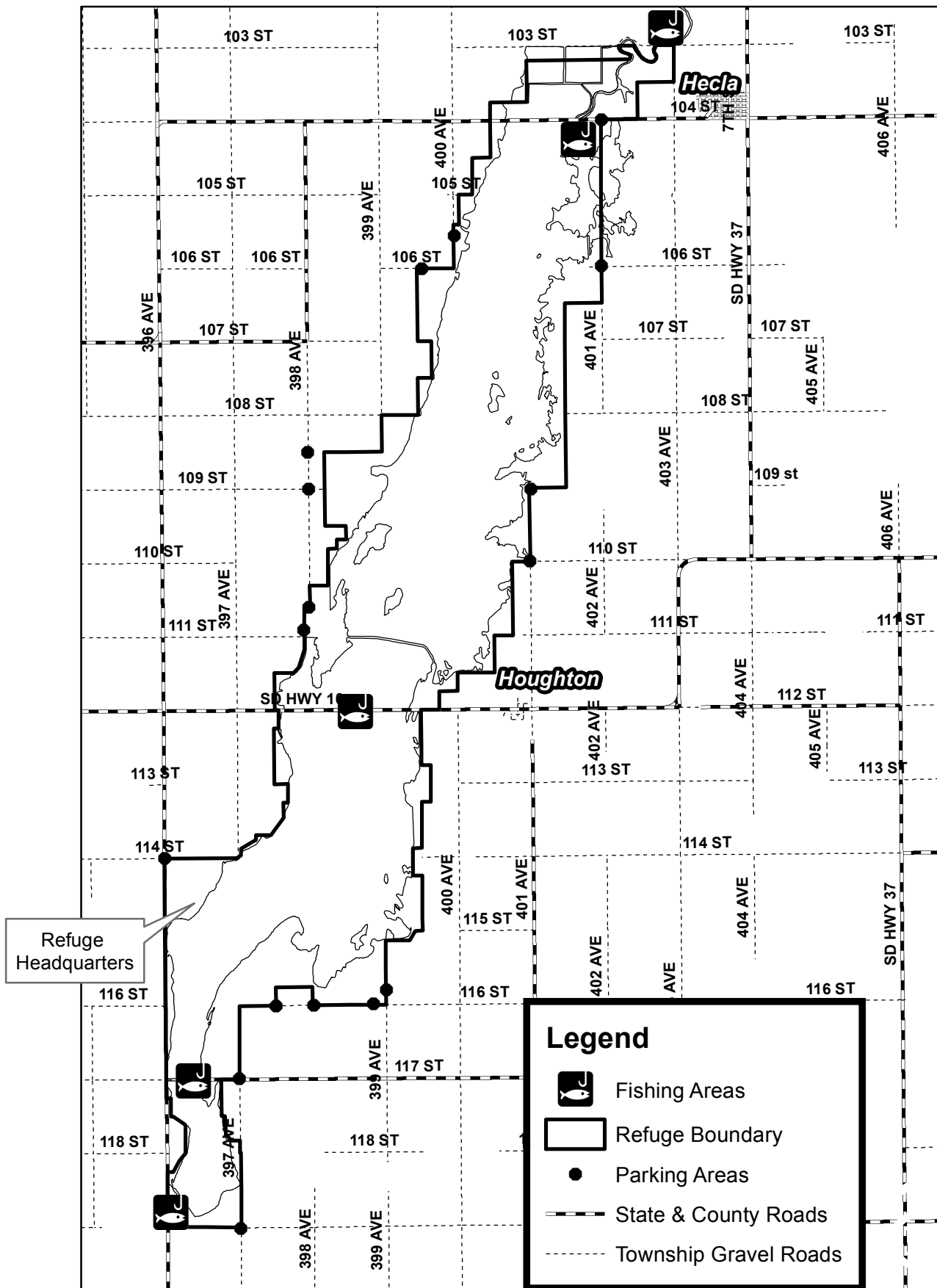
### All Season Regulations:

- Fishing is allowed **only** at designated sites marked on the map. Please stay within the fishing areas and obey all signs.
- All state fishing regulations apply. Please consult the South Dakota Fishing Handbook for further information or special regulations pertaining to the James River.
- The Refuge is open daylight hours only. This includes from ½ hour before sunrise to ½ hour after sunset.
- Boating (motorized or non-motorized) is not allowed. Motorized vehicles are not allowed on the ice during the winter season.
- Fishing from bridges on Brown County 5 & 16, and State Highway 10 is prohibited.
- Ice shacks or houses must be removed daily. No overnight ice shacks allowed. Power augers are permitted.
- No open fires and please do not litter. Take your trash with you when you leave, including fish debris. Help keep *your* National Wildlife Refuge clean.
- Ice conditions change rapidly near bridges and water control structures. Be aware of current ice conditions. Use caution!
- Space is limited, be courteous. When parking along road grades, please pull completely off the road to avoid hazards to yourself and to passing traffic.
