Award winning and widely published local nature photographer John Reed continues the popular photo workshops at Okefenokee in 2019. Both classroom lessons & hands on shooting, beginning with a “bootcamp” on camera controls so everybody is all set for the morning shoot. The rest of the morning is then spent in the refuge “hands on” shooting. This field work also includes hands-on lessons, many tips, and of course any individual help from John as needed or requested. We return for lunch after which there is more time in the classroom with presentations and lessons on digital photography fundamentals and using your camera more effectively. We finish with an afternoon final walking shoot for photos in the immediate area surrounding the classroom.

Location: Okefenokee National Wildlife Refuge, entrance located approximately 8 miles southwest of Folkston Georgia, off Highway 121/23. Proceed in the Refuge roughly 3 more miles to the Visitor Center Classroom.

Cost: Saturday \$60 if paid in advance, \$65 at the door. Credit card, cash, check, or money order accepted. (Note, \$5 entrance fee into Okefenokee NWR is not included in the workshop fee). Registration is non-refundable but may be applied towards a future workshop should you have to cancel.
