



**Horicon Marsh Joint Trapping Bid Procedures  
2021-2022 Season**  
*U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service-Horicon National Wildlife Refuge  
Wisconsin Dept. of Natural Resources-Horicon Wildlife Area*



1. The trapping season will follow Horicon National Wildlife Refuge (NWR) and Horicon Marsh State Wildlife Area (SWA) Trapping Regulations. Details of the 2021-2022 trapping seasons, trapped species, trapping unit maps, and general rules and considerations for both Horicon NWR and the Horicon SWA will be provided to all interested trappers (Attached) and can also be found at:

2. Twenty-one wetland trapping units will be available for bid on the Horicon NWR and the Horicon SWA.
  - a. Horicon NWR- 11 wetland units will be available for bid
  - b. Horicon Marsh SWA- 10 wetland units will be available to bid
3. Trappers must be at least 18 years of age to bid
4. A minimum bid of \$25 is required per unit, payment will be made only if successful.
5. **All bids including “Horicon Marsh Trapping Bid” (Attached) must be sealed in an envelope and be returned to HORICON MARSH EDUCATION AND VISITOR CENTER OFFICE via mail or delivered to a drop box marked “Trapping Bids” located under the carport by 6:00 p.m. Wednesday October 6, 2021. Bids received by mail must be post-marked by Wednesday October 6, 2021 to be valid. Last day to receive mail is Tuesday, October 12. Bids will not be accepted via email/phone/text/or fax.**

6. As in previous years, trappers may bid on all trapping units but trappers can only win one of the trapping units on the Horicon Marsh (i.e., 1 trapper cannot win and trap units on both the NWR and SWA). If there is a tie for highest bid, a random drawing will determine who is awarded the trapping unit. If any unit(s) are not bid on or if there is no winning bid, those unit(s) will not be trapped for the 2021-2022 season.
7. Opening of the bids will take place on **Wednesday October 13, 2021 at 9:00am**. Successful applicants will be notified by phone call on the same day. Winning bids will be posted at the Horicon Marsh Education and Visitor Center (near drop box at carport) on the same day. Results can also be emailed upon request.
8. Information provided on the bid may not be altered once the bid has been submitted. Inaccurate, misleading, or missing information shall void the bid. Both the USFWS and the DNR reserve the right to reject any or all bids.

9. Successful applicants shall make a full bid payment **by 5:00pm on Friday October 15, 2021.** **Payments received by mail must be post-marked by this date.** All payments and payment related questions can be directed to the trapping program contacts noted below.
  - a. Horicon NWR- Payments will be accepted by check, money order, debit card, or credit card. No cash will be accepted. Checks and money orders shall be made payable to "U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service." Credit/debit card payments will be accepted via phone. *For payments submitted via mail please note on envelope: "Attention: Horicon NWR Trapping Program"*
  - b. Horicon SWA- will only accept checks or money orders. Checks and money orders shall be made payable to the "Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources." Cash will not be accepted this year due to current safety precautions and changes in operational procedures. *For payments submitted via mail please note on envelope: "Attention: Horicon SWA Trapping Program"*
10. Neither the DNR nor USFWS will re-bid trapping units that do not receive full payments by the October 15<sup>th</sup> deadline. These units will be forfeited and will not be trapped for the 2021-2022 season.
11. Trapping permits to successful bidders for both the Horicon NWR and Horicon SWA will be issued after payment is received. Due to current operational restrictions, permits will be issued by mail/email.
12. Senior/Disabled Trapping Units:
  - a. Horicon NWR- One unit will be set aside for seniors or trappers with a disability. Seniors must be 62 years of age or older and trappers with disabilities must have a valid disabled hunting/trapping permit from the State of Wisconsin-DNR. Two trappers will be randomly drawn for trapping in this area, at no charge. The drawing will be held on the same day of the bid opening and take place prior to the opening of bids. All bids received from trappers selected for the senior unit will be removed from the bidding. Selected trappers will be notified on the same day.

Trappers interested in the senior drawing shall fill out the "Senior/Disabled Trapping Unit Entry Form" (Attached). Entry forms must be returned to Horicon Marsh Education and Visitor Center Office drop box or postmarked by bidding deadline (**See #5 Instructions above**). You may also call or email to enter the drawing by the above deadline by contacting the Horicon NWR trapping program contact.
  - b. Horicon SWA- One unit will be available at no charge to any interested disabled trapper (must possess a disabled hunting permit), or Senior Citizen (age 65 +). Trappers must obtain a permit by contacting the Horicon SWA trapping program contact.
13. Youth Trapping Units: One unit will be available at no charge to any interested youth between the ages of 12 to 17 on both the Horicon Marsh State Wildlife Area and Horicon National Wildlife Refuge. A free permit can be obtained by contacting the respective NWR or SWA trapping program contacts.
14. Upland Trapping Permits: Permits will be given free of charge to persons with a valid State of Wisconsin trapping license and are included with all wetland unit permits. Upland permits separate from wetland permits will be available beginning October 13 and can be obtained by contacting the respective NWR or SWA trapping program contact.
15. Interested trappers are encouraged to scout the trapping units prior to the auction

- a. Horicon NWR: Scouting on the refuge areas that will be open to trapping will be allowed on Monday, October 4 and Tuesday, October 5, daylight hours only. Interested trappers must obtain a scouting permit at the Refuge Office/Visitor Center off of County Road Z (W4279 Headquarters Road, Mayville, WI 53050) before accessing the units. Scouting permits and bidding forms may be picked up outside at the main entrance to the Visitor Center on the scouting days. A scouting permit can also be obtained by emailing a request to the Horicon NWR contact.
- b. Horicon SWA: Trappers may scout, by foot, or boat at any time.

\*\* Trappers may bid on all trapping units but can only win one of the trapping units on the Horicon Marsh. Units will be awarded to the highest bidder overall. If there is a tie for highest bid on a unit, a random draw will occur. When a trapper is awarded a unit based on high bid, all other bids from that trapper are removed from bidding process and the next highest bid automatically moves into first place for the remaining unawarded units. Only rank units in order of preference if your bid is the same amount for multiple units (i.e., rank units if you bid \$100 on multiple units). Preference ranking will only be necessary and used if a trapper bids the same amount for multiple units AND is high bid with that amount. Preference order rank is not used between trappers.
