2021 Spring Turkey Hunt Lottery Information

Turkey hunting on Great Bay National Wildlife Refuge will be permitted during New Hampshire's regular Spring Turkey Hunt season (May 1-31, 2021) and during the Youth Hunt (April 24-25, 2021).

How to Apply

Each hunt applicant must submit a completed Great Bay Spring Turkey Hunt Lottery Entry Form.

Application Restrictions:

- A hunter's name can appear on ONLY one application. The same name(s) on multiple applications will cause all applications containing those names to be rejected.
- Youth hunters must provide the name of their intended Adult Mentor.

Hunt Lottery Entry Forms will be accepted at Parker River National Wildlife Refuge, 6 Plum Island Turnpike, Newburyport, MA, 01950 from March 1 thru COB on March 31, 2021. Applications may also be emailed to parkerriver@fws.gov or faxed to (978) 465-2807.

Selection Process

8 hunters will be selected by lottery. Preference for up to half of the permits will be given to youth, hunters with disabilities, or first time hunters. Selected applicants will be notified by April 10, 2021 via email or letter. Due to the challenging economic times tied to the COVID pandemic, hunt permit fees are waived for 2021.

Scouting Days

Scouting is permitted beginning one week prior to the Youth Hunt opening.

State and Refuge Regulations

Great Bay NWR is located entirely within the Town of Newington, NH. Hunters are responsible for knowing and complying with all New Hampshire hunting regulations, as published in the 2021 New Hampshire Hunting Digest. In addition, hunters are responsible for knowing and complying with the regulations of Great Bay National Wildlife Refuge. Failure to do so may result in suspension of the hunting permit, future hunting privileges and/or the issuance of a violation notice.
