Think of yourself as a visitor, a guest in someone else's home.


- Please stay on the trails - no off trail use.

- Pets are allowed, but must be on a leash - please clean up after them.
- No fires, camping, or fireworks.
- No hunting or trapping.
- No collecting - please leave plants, animals, and artifacts where they are.
- No overnight parking.

Brice Prairie Trails

- Paved Trails - Open to bicycles and foot traffic with a slope of 5% or less. After a rainstorm the surface may be slippery. Trails not maintained in the winter.
- Visitor Center Loop (0.31 mile, paved)
- Main Trail (0.33 mile, paved)
- South Loop (0.28 mile, paved)
- Gravel Trails - Open to foot traffic only with a slope of 5% or less. After a rainstorm or spring thaw the surface may be soft.
- North Loop (0.64 mile, gravel)
- ▲ South Loop (0.44 mile, gravel)
