Example:

Take your animal type and multiple by the Animal Unit Equivalents. Say you have 13 Cow/Calf pairs, multiple 13 by 1.20 you will get 15.6 AU's. Do this with all of your animals and add them together to find your total AU's.

Example

Example:

To calculate Animal Unit Months (AUM) we take the number of days grazed and divide that by 30. Say you graze a pasture for 21 days divide that by 30, you get 0.7. Multiple that by your Total AU's 28.5 x 0.7 you get 19.95 AUM. Say your bid was \$15.11 your bill would come to a total of \$301.44.
