During scheduled events please use these directions to the San Pablo Bay National Wildlife Refuge Office and Sonoma Land Trust Baylands Center

The San Pablo Bay National Wildlife Refuge office is located on the south side of Highway 37 between Lakeville Highway and Highway 121 in Petaluma, California. The physical address for the office is 2100 Highway 37, Petaluma, CA.

Directions to the office from San Francisco/Novato

From Highway 101, exit Highway 37 East towards Vallejo. Once you reach a traffic light at Lakeville Highway/Reclamation Road, turn right on Reclamation Road. About 600 meters down you will come to a big yellow gate that should be open (for scheduled events ONLY). Continue past the gate and follow Reclamation Road as it turns left. About ¼ mile down you will come to a fork in the road. Take the left hand road (which is paved). This will take you straight to our headquarters building and the Baylands Center.

Directions to the Office from Sacramento/Vallejo

From I-80, and exit Highway 37 West towards San Rafael. Go past Hwy 121. At the next traffic light at Lakeville Highway/Reclamation Road, turn left. About 600 meters down you will come to a big yellow gate that should be open (for scheduled events ONLY). Continue past the gate and follow Reclamation Road as it turns left. About ¼ mile down you will come to a fork in the road. Take the left hand road (which is paved). This will take you straight to our headquarters building and the Baylands Center.
