You may apply in person at the Refuge Office (Mon.-Fri. 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.) during the month of August of the current year. Cash, checks or money orders will be accepted for hunt fee payments. Mailed application and hunt fee can be sent to: Laguna Atascosa NWR, 22817 Ocelot Road, Los Fresnos, TX 78566. Applicants are limited to two archery hunts per year.

Hunt fees sent by mail must be in the form of a personal check or money order only. **Mailed applications must be postmarked during the month of August of the current year.** Make checks or money orders payable to the **U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service**. All hunt fees are non-refundable and permits are sold on a first-come, first-serve basis. If a hunt is already full when you apply, your fees will be returned to you. **Mailed applications not postmarked during the month of August will be returned.**

The Laguna Atascosa National Wildlife Refuge reserves the right to deny or revoke any permit due to regulation infractions, aggressive and abusive demeanor or any reason that displays an act of unprofessionalism to any refuge personnel or fellow hunters.

Privacy Act Statement - Archery Hunt Permit

4. Any information requested is required to receive a permit. Failure to answer questions may jeopardize the eligibility of individuals to receive a permit.
