


Parking Lot & One-Lane Closures

As a part of our Beach Road paving project, our contractor has installed these "filter berms". A filter berm is designed to help control erosion and prevent runoff from carrying construction materials into the rest of the refuge. **Please, help us protect the refuge during this project and be careful not to move or drive on the filter berms.**



Beach Road to be Paved

September 20, 2016 – January 1, 2017

This fall, we will have crews repaving Beach Road. The project will include paving of the parking lots at the Lighthouse Trail and Woodland Trail. Throughout the paving process, ½ mile portions of the road will be reduced to one-lane traffic with flaggers. For your safety, parking lots will be closed while they are being paved. Announcements of these temporary closures will be posted on our website and in our visitor center. Please proceed with caution while driving on the refuge.
