Water Conditions Improve at Bear River Migratory Bird Refuge

As of November 1, water conditions have improved and the tundra swans are arriving. Visitors can see the swans at a distance along the north leg of the Auto Tour Route.

For waterfowlers, all Hunt Units are open and accessible. Additionally, Willard Spur conditions now allow for airboat access. The Handicap Access Hunt Blind is also open with good conditions and can be reserved by calling 435-734-6422.

The Wildlife Education Center is located at 2155 W. Forest St., Brigham City, one block west of I-15 at Exit 363. The Center offers interactive exhibits, wetland diorama, 2 1/4-miles outdoor trail, and is open Monday through Friday 8 am-5 pm and Saturdays 10 am- 4 pm. The Center is closed all federal holidays. The Auto Tour Route is open every day of the year from sunrise to sunset. Please call for more information 435-734-6422.
