
Spring Graze- 30 cow/calf pair on Bacon WPA in 2021

Requirements

Cooperator is encouraged to check the condition of the fences prior to bidding. Some boundary fences may be in poor condition due to snow and/or high water. Should the cooperator choose to repair the permanent barbed wire fence, the materials will be provided by the US Fish & Wildlife Service. It is preferred that the cooperator use their own materials and keep track of what they use on the WPA and the US Fish & Wildlife Service will reimburse the cooperator for the materials. Should the cooperator choose to use electric fence, the cooperator will be required to use their own materials.
