

### Columbia Mine Preserve Hiking Trail Map - Public Use Regulations

Columbia Mine Preserve consists of 1,043 acres. This area was acquired in 2012 by the Sycamore Land Trust. Because the Columbia Mine Preserve is privately owned, this area is subject to **different public access and use regulations**. Public use is managed through a cooperative agreement with Patoka River National Wildlife Refuge and Management Area.

The Columbia Mine Unit is open from one-half hour before legal sunrise to one-half hour after legal sunset.

#### The following activities are **prohibited** on Columbia Mine Preserve

| <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Littering/dumping.</li><li>• Use or possession of alcoholic beverages.</li><li>• Target practice or random shooting.</li><li>• Camping/overnight parking.</li><li>• Campfires.</li><li>• Swimming.</li><li>• Use of fireworks.</li><li>• Dogs running loose or not on leash.</li><li>• Taking or attempting to take any wildlife or wildlife parts (e.g. shed antlers) with exception noted below.</li><li>• Trapping furbearers or other animals.</li></ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Taking, cutting or destroying any plants or parts thereof including flowers, fruits, nuts, fungi, herbs, shrubs, or trees.</li><li>• Use of off-road vehicles, horses, mules, llamas, and bicycles other than on maintained county road right-of-ways.</li><li>• Blocking gates or roadways with vehicles.</li><li>• Searching for or removing any object of antiquity including arrowheads, pottery, beads, etc. Use of metal detectors or digging for artifacts.</li><li>• Use of airboats and gasoline-powered boat motors.</li><li>• Boats must be clean and free of any plant or animal material or water before entering water bodies.</li></ul> |

#### Hunting Dates On Columbia Mine Preserve & Refuge Restricted Land for the 2018-2019 Season

Columbia Mine Preserve and the 48-acre tract of Refuge Restricted land **are closed to hunting all game animals** except for:

1. White-tailed deer during the first week (7 days) of the State-defined seasons for  
Archery                      October 1 – 7, 2018  
Firearms                      November 17 – 23, 2018  
Muzzleloader                December 8 – 14, 2018
2. Wild turkey only during the State-defined spring season (April 24 – May 12, 2019). Fall season wild turkey hunting is prohibited.

**All visitors in the field must wear fluorescent orange hat or vest during the above listed hunting dates.**

**Please take notice:** All general refuge public use regulations apply when on the Columbia Mine Preserve. Enforcement of use regulations will be carried out by both Federal and State Conservation Officers. ***Hunting and fishing regulations for other refuge lands are covered in a separate brochure available at the Refuge Office.***
