

Calendar of Events- Muscatatuck NWR- 2016

Jan. 1- Christmas Bird Count. Bird inventory of the refuge starts at 7:30 am at Visitor Center. Everyone welcome, and free hot lunch provided by refuge Friends group.

Feb. 27 – Bird Jackson County. View Jackson County bald eagles, sandhill cranes (weather permitting) and let the youngsters in your family do a Junior Duck Contest drawing.

March/April- Indiana Master Naturalist Class. Every Wednesday evening from 6- 9:30 pm. Sessions on birds, plants, geology, wetlands...and lots of other natural history topics. Great learning experience for adults for a small fee.

March 19- Wetland Day. Guided wetland walks/tours starting from refuge Visitor Center.

April 16- Family Fishing Workshop. Bring the family and join us from 9 am-noon to learn the fun of fishing! All equipment provided, and no fishing license needed this Saturday.

April 23– Earth Day Cleanup. Join us for a Volunteer work day cleaning up the refuge! Starts at 9 am at the Visitor Center.

May 14– Wings Over Muscatatuck Bird Festival. A full day of guided bird tours, bird and nature walks, that include bird banding, live birds of prey programs, birdhouse building, kids activities, a bird-calling contest, and the Jr. Duck Stamp Contest awards ceremony.

June 4- Take A Kid Fishing Day. 9 am – 2 pm around the Visitor Center. Lots of fun fishing activities for youngsters that includes fishing lessons on request, loaner equipment, and free lunch.

July 9- Butterfly Count. Volunteers will conduct a “butterfly inventory” of the refuge starting at 9:30 am at Visitor Center.

July 11-15- Junior Master Naturalist Class. Kids version of Indiana Master Naturalist class. Half day sessions and lots of fun.

September 17-50th Anniversary Celebration. The refuge 50th anniversary celebration.
