2014 Deer Hunt Permit and Regulations

Violations of these regulations will result in a federal citation being issued.

1. All state hunting regulations apply.
2. Refuge permit must be carried at all times while hunting. Youth hunters must also carry their Hunter Safety certification cards.
3. Refuge permit is not transferable
4. Motorized vehicle access is not permitted. Overnight parking or camping is not allowed in the refuge or parking lots. Park in designated areas only
5. Motorized boat access on navigable waterways flowing through the refuge is permitted. Boat access into the marsh and pool units is not allowed.
6. Only the red shaded area on your permit map is open to hunting. All other areas are closed.
7. Portable blinds (used during gun hunts) must display a minimum of 100 square inches (or 10"x10") of solid-colored hunter orange material on the external surface visible on all sides of the blind.
8. Vehicle permit must be visible on the dashboard. If using a boat, a copy of the vehicle permit shall be displayed in the boat as well.
9. Tree stands may only be left in place for the duration of your hunt period.
10. Baiting of deer is prohibited.
11. Deer drives are strictly prohibited.
12. One deer per hunt may be taken from the refuge.
