
### **Tract Requirements:**

#### **Special Conditions**

1. Any changes in grazing dates need to be prior approved by the Refuge Manager.
2. The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service reserve the right to terminate any and all agreements.
3. All general conditions listed on the back of the Special Use Permit apply.
4. Less cattle for a longer period of time is permitted by approval of the refuge manager.
5. If sufficient rainfall does not occur to facilitate fall grazing of unit one, the bill will be adjusted accordingly.
6. Fences are in poor to good condition. Please check all fences prior to submitting a bid. All fence maintenance and repairs will be done by the permittee with fence materials supplied by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. Grazing units may also require the use of temporary fence in some areas (not provided by the FWS).
