Growing Wild

Grade Level: PreK - K

Length: 2.5 hours



Description: Students learn the life cycles of animals and plants through observation and hands-on, interactive activities. The program includes two 30-minute hikes through the prairie and along the lakes.

Adventures on the Prairie

Grade Level: 1-3

Length: 2 hours



Description: Students discover the world of the prairie by taking a habitat hike and learning all about prairie wildlife. Includes two 30-minute hikes through the prairie.

Standards Achieved in: Math, Reading, Physical Education, & Science

Home on the Range

Grade Level: 4 - 5

Length: 2.5 hours



Description: Students study the largest land mammal in North America, the bison, through observation and hands-on assembly of a real bison skeleton. This program includes a tour of the bison pasture and black footed ferret activities.
