## **Glacial Ridge NWR Hunting Environmental Assessment – Opportunity for Public Comment**

A draft version of the Glacial Ridge National Wildlife Refuge (NWR) Hunting Environmental Assessment (EA) will be posted on the Refuge’s webpage and will be available for public review and comment from August 18 – September 16, 2017.

This EA outlines three potential alternatives for the future of hunting on the Refuge. Ultimately, the chosen alternative will be developed into a Refuge Hunt Plan and any new hunting regulations (e.g., open areas, huntable species) will go into effect during the 2018 hunting season.
